

Curtis W. Wells Funeral Tomorrow

Final services for Curtis Whitfield Wells will be conducted tomorrow at 2:30 p.m. from the Christian Tabernacle at Callands.

Mr. Wells died yesterday at Memorial Hospital where he had been a patient for the past week. He was 55.

Born at Callands, he had become a well known farmer to that area. He was a member of the Christian Tabernacle at Callands and was active in church affairs until ill health forced his retirement some ten months ago.
