CARRIERE, Jean: He was born 1670 in Normandy, France. He migrated in 1680 to SC and died 1723/24. He married Elizabeth Underwood and was a Cooper in Colleton Co., SC

CARRINGTON, Dr. Peter: He migrated c. 1670 to NH/CT and died 1727. He married Ann Wilmont Lines and was a Physician and a Landowner – 1698.

CARROLL, Charles: He died 1720. He migrated to MD. He married Mary Darnell and was an Attorney General and a Naval Officer.

CARSLEY, Henry: He was born England in 1600 and died in 1640. He married Elizabeth Berriman and was an Original Landowner in Accomack Co., VA – 1633.

CARTER, Edward: He was born c. 1640 and migrated in 1682 to PA where he died 1695. He married Margaret ___?___ and was an early Landowner.

CARTER, Elizabeth: She migrated betw. 1660 and 1664 to VA and died 1704. She married Robert Crawford and was a Landowner, Surry Co., VA – 1679.

CARTER, Giles: He was born c. 1623 and died 1700. He migrated to VA in 1676. He married 1) Elizabeth Tracy and 2) Hanna Crews. He was a Surveyor of Highways in Henrico Co., VA.

CARTER, John: He was born c. 1616 and migrated to MA 1636 and died 1692. He married Elizabeth ___?___ and was a Proprietor in Charlestown Village (Woburn), MA – 1640; Capt. of Woburn Military Co. – 1672 and a Freeman – 23 May 1644.

CARTER, John: He was born 1620 and migrated in 1649 to VA. He died 1669. He married Sarah Ludowe and was on the Council – 1658-89.

CARTER, Robert ("King"): He was born 1663 and died 1732. He married 1) Judith Armistead and 2) Betty Landon. He served in the VA House of Burgesses; in the Colonial Assembly – 1691; was Speaker of the House of Burgesses; and President of the Council of VA.

CARTER, Robert: He was born c. 1668 and migrated and settled in PA where he died c. 1751. He married Lydia Walley and was a Tax Collector, Aston Twp – 1689; a Constable – 1698 and a member of the Assembly from Chester Co., PA.

CARTER, Samuel: He migrated to MA in 1640 and died 1693. He married Eunice Brooks and was a Minister – 1690.

CARTER, Thomas: He migrated in 1638 to MA and died 1676. He married Mary ___?___ and was a Freeman – 1638; and one of the first settlers of Salisbury, MA – 1640.

CARTER, Capt. Thomas, Sr.: He was born c. 1630. He migrated in 1653 and married Katherine Dale. He was a Justice, Lancaster Co., VA – 1663; Deputy Clerk of the County – 1670-74; Original Landowner – 1657; Capt. in Lancaster Militia – 1667; and a member of the House of Burgesses.
