It is interesting to observe the name "Ellis D.". The name ELIAS DENT runs deeply in the POSTON family (Judith Poston, sister of Richard Poston, Sr. of MD had m. the Rev. Hatch Dent in Charles County, MD and ELIAS POSTON, bro. of Richard, was a prominent citizen of Hampshire Co., VA (now WVA).

Finally, it is of note that in neighboring Charlotte Co., VA, there is mention in the order books of this county in 1771, an Abel Jackson who is stated to have been an orphan of (H)Ezekiah Jackson. 1.A. JOHN JACKSON, JR, b. bef. 1750 since he should have been at least 21y old at time of land sale to his brother (above); whether he left the area or remained is also not presently known. In VA PUBLICK CLAIMS: HALIFAX CO by Abercrombie & Slaten, p. 1, there is a lone mention of a JOHN JACKSON: "JOHN JACKSON 1 horse 12 years State 16 pounds" (certificate probably granted in 1781 or 1782). The placement of this JOHN JACKSON is not known. HALIFAX CO VA MAR 1753-1800, Knorr, p. 39, lists a SALLY JACKSON m. 12 Nov 1798 to MATTHEW MARKHAM, "d/o JOHN JACKSON who consents"; Edmund Chisum, Sur.; Mason Murphy, wit.

2.A.1. ABEL JACKSON, b. 1781; d. ? (living In Pittsy. Co., 1850); m. in Halifax Co., VA on 10 Mar 1800, SALLY CONNER, b. prob. c1779; Ephraim Jackson, Sur.; wit. were Jessee Owen and Wm. Owen. Sally signed her own consent. She may have been SARAH ELIZABETH CONNER since records of son, James Jackson proclaim his parents to have been "Abel and Elizabeth" Jackson. This "Betsey Jackson", b. c1781 was still living in Pittsy Co., 1850c. In a check of the HALIFAX CO VA PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX BOOKS, up to 1800 there is no mention of Abel Jackson. He appears in Book A in 1801, Book B in 1802, 1803 (A), 1804 (B), 1805 (A) and there is no mention of him bet. 1806-1809. In neighboring Pittsylvania Co., VA, no mention is found of Abel Jackson 1795-1809. He appears there in 1810 through 1812, disappears from the books from 1813 - 1816, reappears in 1817 through

THE JACKSONS OF HALIFAX, PITTSYLVANIA, AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES VIRGINIA

Given the almost ubiquitous nature of the JACKSON surname, the JACKSONs of Washington Co., VA are of varied background. Some of the lines; however, may well be related when one extends back far enough in history.

Halifax Co., VA, named for George Montagu Dunik, Second Earl of Halifax and president of the Board of Trade from 1748-1761, was formed from Lunenburg Co. in 1752. The earliest land records of this county antedate its formation by about two years. A HISTORY OF HALIFAX CO., (VA), Wirt Johnson Carrington, Appeals Press, Ind., Rich., VA, 1924, pp. 37-38, "Extracts from Court Records, Deeds, etc.", in a list of persons who took up land in the year 1750, the name of WILLIAM JACKSON is found. It is not clear in the cited work if it is relevantly tied, but preceeding the aforementioned list, in a dense paragraph is written, "...366 a. on Br. of Runaway Creek." At this time, it is unknown whether this WM JACKSON is related to the Jacksons detailed in this history or if they came to Halifax Co. from Amelia Co., VA, another possibility. It is hoped that future research will provide this information.

The records of Halifax Co., VA attest that in addition to John, Sr., John, Jr., and Ephraim Jackson (see below), in the 1780's, there was also a SIMEON (Simon) JACKSON. Although no tie-in can presently be established, it is interesting to observe the occurrence of the names "Levi" and "Eli" in both families as well as other more common names. The referenced SIMON JACKSON, a great grandson of JAMES JACKSON (inventory of est., Norfolk Co., VA, 19 Jul 1667) and ELIZA_____, grandson of JAMES JACKSON, Jr. and MARGERY SYMON, and s/o JOHN JACKSON and ANNA PATIENCE PRIDDY, was chr. 7 Jan 1747, Chowan co., NC; d. 21 Nov 1820 Russell Co., VA; m. at Lutheran Church, Denton, Davidson Co., NC on 28 Jul 1767, MARTHA SMYTH, d/o Johann Elias Smyth and Margaretha_____. Simon Jackson and Martha Smyth had eleven ch., one of whom was WILLIAM JACKSON, b. 27 May 1773, Concord TWP, Randolph Co., NC; d. supposedly in Muhlenburg Co., KY and bur. on 18 Dec 1843; m. in Russell Co., VA, MARY HUNT, d/o Wm. Hunt, Sr. (ref.: research of Ms. Bernice Chandler, dec., via her dau., Ms. Jean Ellis, Raleigh, NC). One of their children also came to Washington Co., VA, as did some of the JACKSONs detailed herein, JOHN R. JACKSON (c1811 - post-1870) m. c1835, MARY WALDEN, d/o Lewis Walden and Mildred "Milly" Hunt. Along with a lone mention of a JOHN JACKSON, SIMEON (Simon) JACKSON is mentioned multiple times in VA PUBLICK CLAIMS: HALIFAX CO, J. L. Abecrombie & Richard Slatten, as supplying provisions to the patriots bet. 1780 and 1783.
