#### INDEX TO WILLS

The following alphabetical listing covers testators whose wills were probated in Charlotte County, Virginia between May 1765 and February 1799. Where available, a date of writing (first) and date of record (second) has been given. All references are expressed as Will Book Number: Beginning Page Number.

Inventories, some accounts current, and an occasional estate distribution were also recorded in the county will books. Each is very important as a source for genealogical information and can be easily located by using the county's General Index to Wills.

Readers will also find that the first twenty-two pages of Will Book 1 are partially torn. This loss effects to some extent the wills of David Caldwell, Francis Clements, William East, Francis Harwood, James Hudson, Thomas Johns, Francis Mann, Samuel Morton, James Orr, Owen Sullivant, and William Toombs.

Three men from the above list, Francis Clements, Samuel Morton, and William Toombs, were "of Lunenburg County" at the time of writing. It seems reasonable to assume that all lived in the portion of Lunenburg that became Charlotte County in 1764.
