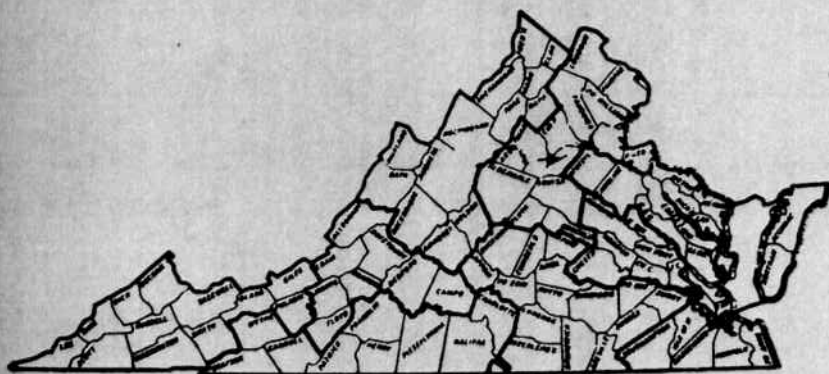

Corod Bott. £0.8.8½. Removed to Bedford about 1786 and then insolvent.

Richard Carter. £9.13.2, account. He died some years ago. The man who married his widow and executrix says it is paid. The estate is very good.

John Coleman. £9.16.3. His son and administrator says he knows nothing about it but expects it's paid. His estate is good.

Henry & Jno. Cox. £20. Henry Cox lives in Tennessee and is good; John Cox lives in Mecklenburg.

Robert Chandler. £8.11.6¼. His son says this debt has been paid. He died some years ago, very able.

George Combs. £6.6.3½. Died some years ago, insolvent.

William Davis. £2.7.4½. He says he has paid this debt long ago.

James Dejarnett. £10.7.4½. He says there is but very little of this debt due; is any, he will pay it.

Henry Daniel. £0.17.3. Died before 1783, solvent.

[P. 16] Robt. B. Munford's Estate. £24.1.10½, account. Left his estate in such a manner that no debts could be recovered of it.

Abraham Easlis. £19.10.2, account. He says he paid this debt some time ago.

Moses Echols. £8.5.2, bond. Died before 1783; left no personal estate.

William Hawkins. £45.18.4½, account. Removed to Georgia in 1786, very able then.

Henry Hopson. £14.19.8½, bond. He removed to Georgia a few years ago and conveyed his property all away to his children and grandchildren.

Herbert Hawkins. £3.1.10½. "I can't find anyone that ever knew him."

George Jones. £7.1.1. He was a free mulatto and was always insolvent; now dead.

Moses Johnson. £1.2.2. Died before 1783 insolvent.

John Irvine. £1.7.5. He says he never had a penny's worth of them without paying the cash for it at the time. He is very able.

Robert Jennings. £2.11.5¼. "I can't find anyone that ever knew him."

George Judge. £35.5.11. He lives in Charlotte.

John Kirby. £0.18.3. He says he owes them nothing.

Henry Kirby. £0.6.0. He says he owes nothing.

William Lawson. £12.1.1¼. He removed many years ago to Georgia; he was very able then.

Thomas Lovelace. £3.18.1½. He says he paid this debt and does not owe them a pence. He is able to pay.

Isaac Lynch. £2.11.11, account. He lives in Campbell.

John Lawson. £57.3.9 3/4. He removed to Georgia many years ago and there died solvent.

Joseph Lee. £43.9.10½, bond. Ran away insolvent before 1783.

Murphy & Green. £9.13.5, account. I can't find out who Murphy & Green was.

John Murphey. £32.14.9. He died in 1787. His widow, who is his administratrix, says he paid the debt many years ago. His estate is good.

Blackman Mosley. £15.5.3, bond. He says he never had any dealings with them, only he bought a hogshead of rum of them for which he paid at the time he got it.

[P. 17] John Moore. £23.14.9½, account. He is dead; his executor says it is certainly paid. His estate is very good.

Herman Miller. £27.11.8½. He says he paid this debt long ago.

Jesse Pleasants. £20.19.6 3/4, bond. He says he paid this debt fourteen years ago to one of Ross' collectors, a Mr. Varnerson.

John Peters. £85.6.7½, account. I can't find out who this man is or where he lives.

John Pulliam. £21.15.1 3/4. He says he paid this debt off in full.

James Poynter. £9.12.9 and £0.14.9. I can find no one that ever knew him.

David Powell. £1.12.9. He says he paid all he ever owed them.

William Purkins. £0.7.0. Died before 1783 insolvent.

David Moore. £2.14.3 3/4. I can't find anyone that can give any account of him.

William Pride. £26.16.8 3/4, bond. Removed to South Carolina in 1788. He was good then.

Walker Robertson. £125.8.9½, account. On examining Walker Robertson's books I find they owe Robertson about £36.

Michael Roberts. £33.7.3½, bond. He died some years ago. I am informed this debt was paid before his death.

Evan Ragland. £11.8.5½, account. He died some years ago. His son says it's paid. His estate is good.

Thomas Robins. £22.10.1. He lives in Gloucester and is very able.

Peter Rodgers. £4.12.7. He died about the close of the war, insolvent; no representative.

Samuel Roberts. £24.6.6½.

William Roberts £58.5.1½. Both Samuel and Willm. Roberts ran away before 1783, insolvent.

Richard Spencer. £121.18.3/4. Died before 1783, insolvent.
