

George received early land grants in Wilson Co., Tenn., and George and Samuel Tittle were on tax list there 1803-07. They moved to Smith Co., Tenn., where George died in 1819. Since he married in Va. in 1783, he could not be father of Samuel unless that was a second marriage. Samuel Tittle was in the census of 1820 and 1830 in Smith Co., Tenn. A deed shows him in Cannon Co., Tenn., 1836; where he died 1838, leaving wife Susannah (born 1772; who was she?) and children Anthony, Samuel Jr., Adam, Robert, Hyram Young, Elizabeth (m. --- Owen), Serena (m. --- Dutton), and Sabrena (m. Jonas Nokes). Who were parents of Samuel Tittle Sr.? Is father Anthony Tittle of Wilson Co., Tenn., or of Henry Co., Va.? Mrs. Balfour H. Clark, 1307 West 3rd Ave., Corsicana, Texas 75110.

894. CARTER-CROCKETT-BATES-DRAKE. Will pay for proof of parentage of George Carter (ca.1740-1815) and wife Mary --- of Halifax, Pittsylvania, Montgomery and Wythe cos., Va. Three known sons: William married Unity Bates (to Ky.); Robert married Jane Crockett; Francis Jackson married Esther Crockett, dau. of James and Mary (Drake) Crockett. 895. BARRON. Jesse Barron (died 1811) and Dr. Hendly Barron (died 1822; wife Margery) came from Charles Co., Md., 1791 and 1792 respectively, settling in Prince William Co., Va. They owned lands on Cedar Run and Occoquan; post office was Dumfries. Family connections were Latimers, Hansons, Washingtons and Masons. 896. KIMBROUGH-THOMSON. Want proof of perentage of Samuel Kimbrough, born ca.1735 in New Kent Co.(?), Va.; married ca.1754; went to Bourbon Co., Ky., 1787; died there 1810; named wife Cary in his will. Would like her maiden name and parentage. Want was relationship between Kimbrough and Samuel Thomson who died Louisa Co., Va., 1753. Mrs. B. R. 897. GILLIAM-HOBSON. Richard Holland Gilliam (1809-1802), born and died Buckingham Co., Va., buried Lynchburg (son of Richard, son of Epaphroditus), married 1st, 1847, Virginia C. Holman (two sons, William Ernest and Richard Lee Gilliam); 2nd (we think) Mrs. Mary Page (Hobson) Flippin (Flippen); 3rd, 1863, Hettie Williams of Lynchburg (no issue). Need data on 2nd wife who may have had child born 1840 by her 1st marriage. Gannot find Mary P. Flippen and/or child in 1850 census. From Bible (two town pages only): Marriages, "Richard H. Gilliam [torn] Flippin 15th Dec. [year torn, but 1852]". Births, "[torn]ppen 5th Jany 1840". Births, "R.H. & M.P. Gilliam" had Glover Daniel, Ann Virginia, Benjamin Hobson, Floyd Herbert and Marrion Gilliam, born 1853 to 1859; all died young except Floyd Herbert. Deaths, "Mary Page Gilliam 22nd Sept. 1860, her infant was born dead on the
